7. Events for drivers of vehicles and Heads of motor transport enterprises, pedestrians involving representatives of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Ukraine, National Police of Ukraine, State Service of Ukraine for Transport Safety, Agency for Infrastructure Restoration and Development of Ukraine, Ministry of Health of Ukraine:

- set of measures related to raising awareness of road users about the negative consequences of road accidents and stimulating actions aimed at eliminating the main risk factors for road traffic injuries, in particular, prioritizing the unimpeded passage of ambulances at intersections when blue flashing lights and special audible signals are activated, dangerous behaviour of pedestrians on streets, pedestrian crossings, non-compliance with the speed limit, improving the culture of road user's behavior when ambulances are approaching in urban areas;
- holding a campaign “Attention! Emergency Vehicles!”, ensuring the priority passage of emergency vehicles (ambulances, police, and rescue services).;
- measures of state control (supervision) over compliance by road carriers with the legislation on road transport, control over the implementation of the rules for the provision of passenger road transport services, preventive;
- training of school bus drivers and accompanying persons on the pupils' life safety when using a school bus and the algorithm of actions in case of receiving Air Raid Alert signal to ensure the safety of pupils' lives and health during their transportation to and from general secondary education institutions.
- inspection of sections of public roads of national importance, that are: adjacent to the territory of children's and educational institutions and along which school bus routes pass; entrance to railway crossings; accidental dangerous plots and accident areas on the availability of appropriate warning road signs 1.39 and 1.41 together with the appropriate plates to them;
- measures to eliminate the identified shortcomings in operational maintenance during inspections;
- conducting master classes by safety services – demonstration of the work of rescuers, police, and explosive experts;
- conducting awareness-raising activities regarding the actions of road users during an attack, sustaining injuries while traveling in a vehicle or other means of transport, and the procedure for premedical care in these cases;



- training and professional development of drivers in providing premedical care considering mine and explosive injuries;
- explanatory work on the expediency of using child car seats, seat belts;
- explanatory work on the unacceptability of being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs while driving a vehicle;
- explanatory work among the public on compliance with traffic rules.

8. Measures to improve traffic safety, in particular, at railway crossings and measures aimed at improving road safety and reducing the level of accidents within railway crossings and technological passages by:

- discussion of urgent issues: what are the first steps that need to be taken to adapt Ukrainian carriers to the requirements of the EU Mobility Package in terms of transport safety? How can the state effectively control the technical condition of commercial transport, considering the increase in the number of road accidents due to worn-out vehicle fleets? How has the war in Ukraine affected the level of safety of freight and passenger transport, and what risk compensation mechanisms can be introduced for carriers? How effective is the control of compliance with traffic rules by passenger transport drivers on intra-regional routes, and what measures can be implemented to reduce the number of violations?
- conducting specific trainings with teaching staff, technical and medical personnel, and school bus drivers on compliance with traffic rules;
- monitoring the professional development of medical personnel who conduct pre-trip and post-trip medical check-ups of vehicle drivers;
- equipping visual information and holding meetings in labor collectives to inform about the aim of the Road Safety Week, considering the state, causes of road traffic injuries and the level of transport discipline;
- conducting unscheduled briefings with employees drivers on compliance with requirements of traffic rules;
- conducting with drivers unscheduled classes with participation of employees of medical institutions to improve their practical skills in providing premedical care to victims of road accidents;



- restoration of road signs and road marking within the area of railway crossings;
- ensuring that drivers of vehicles at railway crossings have regulatory visibility of the train approaching the crossing;
- elimination of shortcomings identified during commission inspection of railway crossings.

## 10. Events dedicated to children’s road safety:

- meeting with police representatives: “Traffic Rules Through the Eyes of Children.” Demonstration of educational videos and analysis of real traffic situations;
- conducting explanatory work on the mandatory wearing of reflective elements during dark hours;
- awareness of urgent road safety information on the YouTube channel «Безпечна країна» (“Safe country”) <http://www.youtube.com/c/Безпечнакраїна>;
- meeting with a juvenile prevention / patrol police inspector: “Safe Behaviour on the Street and in Transport”;
- visits to educational institutions by ambulance crews to practice emergency response procedures in case of traffic accidents;
- discussion of the issue of regulating traffic for two-wheeled vehicles equipped with electric motors, due to their widespread use among young people, and conducting educational events for students to familiarize them with traffic rules and behaviour on the road;
- holding parents’ meetings in the format of a discussion platform – a meeting with parents, police officers, and psychologists on the topics of “Parents as Drivers and Pedestrians: Responsibility for Children” , “Electric Scooters and Teenagers: New Challenges.” The goal is to discuss the role of parents in teaching traffic rules, in particular through personal example, and the risks of modern means of transportation;



- conducting class hours / discussions, information sessions on the topics: “The Way to School”, “Traffic Lights are Our Helpers”, “Pedestrians and Roads”, “Safe Journey to School in Winter/Summer”, “I am a Pedestrian. My Rights and Responsibilities”, “Safe Passenger Behaviour”, “Road Hazards: How to Avoid Them”, “Youth for Road Safety”, “Rules for Cyclists, Drivers, Passengers”, “Driver and Pedestrian Responsibility According to the Law”.
- conducting discussions / trainings on the topics: “Why Do Teenagers Get into Traffic Accidents?”, “Responsibility for Traffic Rules Violations”, “Safe Cycling and Scooter Riding”, “Media Literacy and Videos About Traffic Accidents: How Not to Imitate Dangerous Behaviour”, “Is It Worth Risking Your Life for Speed?”, “Safe Mobility and Modern Transport”,
- conducting game events / quizzes / quests / online games: “Road Signs are Our Friends,”, “In the Country of Road Signs”, “Safe route”, “Safe Traffic is Cool”, “Know and Act Correctly!”, “Know the Rules of the Road”, “My Safe Way Home”, “We Know, We Learn, We Follow”. Viewing the presentation “Safety at Public Transport Stops. Passenger Safety”;
- practical work / creation of infographics or videos for social networks / student projects / volunteer activities: creation of a model of a safe route to school, colouring road signs, watching cartoons “Aunt Owl’s Lessons on Traffic Rules”, “Safe Way to School”, “Be Visible in the Dark”, “Youth for Life!”;
- use of online traffic situation simulators (e.g. [traffic-safety-game.com](http://traffic-safety-game.com));
- conducting a nationwide flash mob for educational process participants: “I am a Conscious Pedestrian!” (alternative title – “My Safety is in my Hands”);
- monitoring parking in cooperation with the parents' committee to ensure compliance with parking rules near the gates of the institution (contacting the police in case of systematic violations), with the aim of ensuring safe access to the institution and preventing accidents;
- renewal of information and reference corners on road safety, thematic stands at the educational institutions;
- distributing leaflets (memos), information posters on the rules of using public transport and behaviour in it;
- modelling situations “At the Crossroads” and “On the Road”;



- conducting a practical evacuation training in case of an emergency;
- organization of discussions with parents and pupils about the mandatory use of reflective elements (vest, tape, sticker) in the dark by education seekers;
- holding thematic educational hours and extracurricular activities (competitions for young traffic inspectors, a game of teams of the Club of cheerful and the smartest young traffic inspectors, brain-ring);
- conducting master classes on provision of premedical care to victims of road accidents;
- designing of thematic information stands, book exhibitions, creation of thematic lap books;
- conducting a survey of the areas adjacent to educational institutions in order to eliminate shortcomings in organization of traffic;
- monitoring the wishes of parents and teachers to improve the organization of traffic near educational institutions;
- creating a public information Telegram channel with a high-quality feed of content related to road traffic issues;
- briefings with school buses drivers on accident prevention;
- conducting a cycle of events on practical skills of behaviour in case of emergency situations, detection of mine-explosive devices etc.

#### 11. Development and implementation of regional and local road development and safety programs approved by local authorities:

- implementation of measures for the development and improvement of road infrastructure in accordance with applicable regulations and technical conditions, counteract and preventing offences in the field of road safety;
- implementation of measures aimed at creating conditions for accessibility of persons with disabilities to transport, transport and road infrastructure facilities;
- implementation of measures to ensure the stable functioning of traffic lights, including maintenance of installed uninterruptible power supply devices that ensure the operation of traffic lights in the absence of electricity, renewal of road markings, repair of road surfaces, installation of devices to restrict vehicles from driving on sidewalks;



- conducting working meetings with urban passenger transport operators on maintaining vehicles in good working order, complying with passenger transport rules, and traffic rules.
